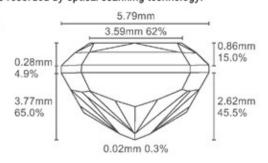
The colored areas of the symmetry image are indications of light handling ability, giving a visual representation of proportions and facet alignment.
